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GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Candidates are advised to read the instructions carefully before filling up the application form and dispatching it.

The minimum qualifications required for appointment in the University as laid down by the UGC (approved by the Government in G.O.Ms.No.14 Higher Education (UE.II) Dept. dated 20-2-2010 and G.O.Ms.No.38 Higher Education (UE.II) Dept., dt.23-06-2016 of Government of Andhra Pradesh and contained in the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2010 vide letter No. F. 3-1/2009 dated 30.06.2010, No.F.1-2/2016 (PS/Amendment), dt. 11-07-2016) for the posts of Assistant Professors are given below. The candidates shall satisfy these requirements, in addition to the other requirements and desirable qualifications mentioned below:

1. ASSISTANT PROFESSOR: Scale of Pay: Rs. 15600 – 39100 plus AGP Rs.6000/-

A. Minimum Qualifications prescribed for Appointment of Teaching Faculty for Commerce, Economics, English, Law, Library & Information Science, Rural Development, Social Work, Computer Science, Mathematics and Organic Chemistry.

Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% of the marks or equivalent grade where grading system is practiced at the Master's degree level in a relevant/concerned subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

B. Minimum Qualifications for appointment of Teaching Faculty in Education.

Education : Assistant Professor :

- i) A Post Graduate Degree in Education i.e. M.Ed./ M.A. (Education) with 55% marks; and
- ii) A Post Graduate Degree with a minimum of 55% marks in the discipline concerned.

C. Minimum Qualifications for appointment of Teaching Faculty in Computer Science.

Assistant Professor.

- i. B.E./B.Tech., and M.E./M.Tech., in relevant subject with First Class or equivalent either in B.E./B.Tech., or M.E./M.Tech.; OR B.E./B.Tech., and M.C.A. with First Class or equivalent in either B.E./B.Tech., or M.C.A.; OR M.C.A. with First Class or equivalent with two years relevant experience.
- ii. Ph.D. in the faculty of Computer Science or NET/SLET/SET in Computer Science is preferred.

Note: A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks at the graduate and masters level for the SC/ST/Differently-abled (physically and visually differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions.

- a. Relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to Ph.D. degree holders, who passed their Master's degree examination prior to 19th September 1991.
- b. In 7 point scale with letter grade O,A, B, C, D, E & F, the grade "B" shall be regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed.

Other Qualifications required for the posts of Assistant Professors:

- i) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate should have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- ii) Candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum standards and procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

“Provided further, the award of Degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil/Ph.D Programme prior to July 11th, 2009 shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bylaws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and the Ph.D. Candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) Ph.D. Degree of the Candidate awarded in regular mode only;
- b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;
- c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the Candidate had been conducted;
- d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
- e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in Conferences/Seminars, based on his/her Ph.D. work.

(a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro-Vice-Chancellor/Dean (Academic Affairs /Dean (University Instructions).

- iii)“Ph.D. Degree which are pursued either full time or part time will be treated as Degree awarded through Regular Mode provided these are in conformity with the existing Statutes/Bylaws/Ordinances etc., of the Degree awarding University, However, the Ph.D. acquired under distance mode is not permitted”.
- iv) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.
- v) Any other stipulation prescribed by the UGC/such other affiliating Body/State Government, from time to time for the positions of Assistant Professors (Lecturers), shall be mandatory
- vi) A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and Masters level for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Differently – abled (Physical and Visually differently-abled) / Other Backward Castes (OBC) (Non-creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academics record during direct recruitment to Teaching Positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
- vii) A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master’s Degree prior to 19th September, 1991. Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized University shall also be considered eligible.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SCREENING TEST

1. On-line Screening Test

In addition to the minimum qualifications as per the UGC regulations, 2010 amended from time to time, the Candidates shall have to appear the screening test conducted through on-line. The screening test will be conducted either by the University or any other agency entrusted by the University

2. Date & Centre of the Screening Test

The date and venue of the on-line screening test will be communicated through the registered e-mail mentioned in the application of the Candidate. Further, the date of screening test will be communicated through the University website. The Candidates are informed to browse the University website for latest updates.

3. Syllabus of the Screening Test

The syllabus of the screening test is hosted on the University website.

4. Scheme of the Screening Test

The test will consist of two papers. Paper I, common to all Candidates, will be Teaching and Research Aptitude, while Paper II will be concerned subject. Paper I and Paper II put together are for 300 marks. Paper I will contain 120 objective type questions for 120 marks (each question carries 1 mark). For Paper II, the Candidates have to answer 180 objective type questions for 180 marks (each question carries 1 mark). Duration for Paper I is 2 hours & Paper II duration is 3 hours.

5. Negative marks

There will be negative marks for each wrong answer. Each wrong answer will carry 1/3 negative mark for the question.

6. Qualifying marks

The minimum qualifying marks in the on-line screening test for consideration of an eligible candidate to the oral interview in case of OC category is 40%, BC category is 35% and for SC, ST and PH categories is 30%.

7. Oral Interview

The Candidates, who qualify in the screening test, shall be called for oral interview according to the terms and conditions notified in the advertisement by the University.

8. Downloading of the hall tickets

Hall tickets can be downloaded 7 days before commencement of the on-line screening test.

The candidates should submit online application in the prescribed format available in the APSCHE website i.e. <http://sche.ap.gov.in/ASSTPROF/Masters/Home.aspx> or through the link in University website www.brau.edu.in . After submitting the online application, a hard copy of the same should be submitted by post to the Registrar, Dr.B.R.Ambedkar University, Srikakulam – 532410 on or before 06-02-2018, 5:00PM

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

1. The candidate is required to fill in the Pro-forma enclosed to the application form invariably, giving full details of his/her academic record, etc. If the space provided in the application for the qualifications to be furnished in respect of each column is not sufficient, a separate sheet may be attached and the information noted marking the column number against it.
 2. **Separate Application should be submitted for each post.**
 3. Self - attested True Copies of all the testimonials, Educational qualifications, Date of Birth, Caste, Experience, etc., should be enclosed. The original certificates should be produced at the time of interview and at the time of joining, if selected.
 4. (a) Applications from the candidates who are employed should be sent through proper channel accompanied with a letter of consent obtained from the Employer concerned.
(b) Teachers actually in the employment of the University shall apply through proper channel to the post advertised by the University, if they wish to be considered.
(c) If the applicant is selected for the post he/she will be appointed to the post on the minimum pay of the time scale attached to the post and no protection of last pay drawn in the previous employment will be given unless the Selection Committee which selects him/her specifically recommends such protection and the appointing authority accepts it.
 5. **Canvassing in any shape or form will be construed as an absolute disqualification.**
 6. **Experience and qualifications will be reckoned as on the last date for submission of application complete in all respects, that is, 06-02-2018 by 5:00 PM.**
 7. Candidates selected for the posts will be governed by **Contributory Pension Scheme** made applicable to all the newly appointed candidates, as per G.O.Ms. No.653, 654 & 655, Finance (Pen) Dept., dated 22-09-2004. However, Revised Pension Rules for the University Teachers, 1992 as per G.O.Ms.No.276, Education (UE.I) Department dated 02-12-1993 and G.O.Ms.No.227, Education (UE.I) Department dated 2-12-1993 shall be made applicable to those who are in service and governed by Revised Pension Rules for the University Teachers, 1992 with amendments made thereof.
 9. If the authorities decide to interview the candidate, he/she should arrange to be present at the place fixed on the date and time specified at his/her own expenses. The summoning of a candidate for interview conveys no assurances whatsoever that he/she will be selected or recommended.
 10. The University reserves the right to fill or not to fill any of the Post(s) without giving any reason whatsoever.
