Sub: - APSCHE- Irregularities, malpractices and indiscipline prevailed in running M.E/M.Tech and M.Pharmacy courses in Private Unaided PG Professional Colleges in the State- Attention of universities drawn for causing remedial action -Reg.

I wish to bring to the notice of the university authority that the Government has received representations from students, parents and student associations in the state that the managements of the private unaided PG Professional colleges offering M.E/M.Tech, M.Pharmacy, MBA and Pharm-D (PB) courses have been mismanaging the institutions resorting to many irregularities in the conduct of the said PG programmes. The matter is viewed seriously by the Government and directed that immediate steps be taken to remedy the situation in the Institutions by all the concerned.

Further, the Government has noted that academic work in the institutions is totally derailed viz. regular class work is not conducted, students attendance is not insisted, proxy attendance allowed, malpractices in internal examinations, in service candidates were given admission in management seats and such candidates are given attendance, reporting fabricated information to Welfare Departments claiming scholarships, non adherence of the prescribed norms of apex bodies viz. AICTE and PCI etc with regard to infrastructure, training facilities and qualified staff requirements. Claiming of scholarships and Tuition Fee Reimbursement of even such ineligible students has been causing undesirable and increased financial burden on the ex-chequer.

In this regard, I request immediate attention of the university authority on the above aspects to initiate action as per university statutes so as to improve the academic environment of the institutions and also to control such irregular activities and malpractices of the managements.

I further suggest that the services of the senior professors with proven integrity from the university may be utilized either for surprise inspections or inquiry if any mooted and the action taken in the matter shall be communicated directly to the Government in the form of a report under intimation to APSCHE within a period of 15 days.
