NOTICE

Sub: -APSCHE – AC- Re-inspection of Colleges- Applications called for – Managements to apply - Incomplete information submitted by certain colleges- Colleges directed to re-submit applications - Reg.

Ref: Noti.No.APSCHE/AC-II/NDC/UG/PG/2015 dated 07.04.2015.

The A.P State Council of Higher Education vide notification under reference has notified Managements of existing Private Unaided Degree Colleges functioning in rental/leased accommodation to apply for re-inspection to the Council with an objective to know the status of infrastructural and instructional facilities provided by the College Managements in the State of Andhra Pradesh is adequate or inadequate as per Section 9 (2) (b) of G.O.Ms.No. 29 dated 5.2.1987 and as per judgement of Hon'ble High Court in the year 2004.

It is noticed that many of the Managements have not responded to the notification, inspite of the last date for submission of applications for re-inspection being extended several times. Therefore, the Managements who have not applied for reinspection are directed to apply before 30th September, 2015. failing which show cause notice will be initiated against such colleges.

It is also noticed that certain Managements of Private Unaided Degree Colleges who applied for re-inspection of their colleges have submitted incomplete application forms. Most of the columns where vital information is to be filled have been left blank.

In most of the applications, the details of accommodation available has not been filled under Section D 4 (i),(ii) and (iii). Like wise, academic information pertaining to details of courses sanctioned, enrolment of students and details of faculty members under Section E 5 (a), (b) and (c) were not filled. In such cases, it will be presumed by the council that the colleges have not made admissions for the said academic year and such colleges will eventually be recommended for dis-affiliation by the university concerned.

Therefore the Managements of all Private Unaided Degree Colleges who have not applied for re-inspection are directed to apply and Managements who have submitted applications for re-inspection with incomplete/irrelevant information are hereby directed to re-submit application as required failing which a show cause notice will be issued to such colleges before withdrawing the approval granted by the Council.
